## **Instructions and Explanations**

- 1. Full name and address of the actual (re)-exporter, not of an agent. In the case of a personal ownership certificate or of a musical instrument certificate, the full name and address of the legal owner. In the case of a musical instrument certificate, if the applicant is different from the legal owner, the fullname and address of both the owner and the applicant should be included in the form and a copy of a loan agreement between owner and applicant should be provided to the relevant permit issuing authority.

- Full name and address of the actual importer, not of an agent. To be left blank in the case of a personal ownership certificate or of a musical instrument certificate.
- To be left blank in the case of a personal ownership certificate or of a musical instrument certificate.
- To be completed only on the application form in the case of live specimens of Annex A species other than captive bred or artificially propagated specimens.
- 8. Description must be as precise as possible and include a three-letter code in accordance with Annex VII to Regulation (EC) No 865/2006 laying down detailed rules concerning the implementation of Council Regulations (EC) No 338/97 on the protection of species of wild fauna and flora by regulating trade therein.
