Friday 15 Nov 2024

• The hare that was pinned on day one was placed in a box by a steward and examined by the attending veterinary surgeon at the nearest interval. The hare received some painkiller medication and was set aside not to be coursed again for the remaining event (hare tag # 147). The hare was released on the Sunday with the other hares with no injuries present.

Saturday 16 Nov 2024

• The one hare pinned on day one was placed in a box by a steward and examined by the veterinary surgeon at the nearest interval. The attending veterinary surgeon (John Collins) euthanised the hare after examination (hare tag # 103).

Sunday 17 Nov 2024

- One hare did not enter the escape during a course and returned down the field and escaped at the boxing unit, it was observed by CR Ranger Éinne Ó Cathasaigh running into a nearby field until out of sight.
- The release at the conclusion of coursing was well organised. There were sufficient small boxes to carry hares & sufficient vehicles to carry large boxes of hares to release sites. This resulted in all hares being successfully released before sunset with all tags removed.
