At Woodrow APEM Group we carry out surveys on a consultancy basis for developments such as but not limited to windfarm applications, road/bridge maintenance, house demolitions, and quarry expansions. The purpose for which this license is sought for is the potential disturbance while carrying out inspections whilst using torch and endoscope to confirm the presence of and/or signs of roosting bats. This will occasionally include the setting up of night vision aids within roosts while carrying out dusk and dawn surveys on large buildings. For this reason, the maximum number of bats to be disturbed is unknown prior to upcoming survey season.
